Regional Business Leader North America Gas and Power BP Energy Company




Orlando A. Alvarez was named president of BP's North America Gas and Power (NAGP) business in November 2011. Based in Houston, Texas, he is responsible for BP's Gas, Natural Gas Liquids and Power trading, marketing, and supply activities in North America, and is a member BP's global Integrated Supply and Trading (IST) executive leadership team.

Orlando has worked for the company more than 15 years, most recently as the COO of Natural Gas, Trading and Marketing. Prior positions include Head of Western U.S., as well as the Gulf Coast and Eastern regions. During this time, he was a key member of the leadership team that built BP's North America Gas & Power merchant business into one of North America's leading players, providing natural gas, power and risk management services to the industrial and utility sectors across the continent. This strategic position has been achieved by combining BP's global trading experience with its role as one of the largest gas producers in North America.

During his 23 years in the natural gas industry, Orlando has held a wide range of commercial positions, including natural gas trader, producer origination, and supply/transportation manager. He acquired further upstream experience by spending three years on the natural gas liquids end of the business, responsible for commercial delivery across a number of processing facilities on the Gulf Coast.

He entered the business in 1988, as an accountant for a major interstate pipeline, and moved into the commercial end of the business in 1991. It was a move into Strategy and Planning, and subsequently into the Supply Performance group, where he was responsible for monitoring and negotiating take-or-pay agreements with producers that prompted his passion for working on deals and encouraged him to consider moving further downstream into marketing and trading.

Orlando was born in Santa Clara, Cuba and came to the United States at the age of 3, where he lived in New York until his move to Texas in 1975. He currently resides in northwest Houston with his two children, Alexis, 17, and Brandon, 14. Orlando attended Lamar University in Beaumont, Texas, where he received a Bachelor of Business Administration degree in accounting.
