

I am sending this letter to respectfully request that you waive the fine being imposed upon my business, per the enclosed letter .

Back in December 2011, I received a 'Complaint' regarding the PUC Cargo regulations. I took the letter to my insurance agent at Wm R Karschner & Sons and she called your office for me to find out what I needed to do, since I am no longer required to carry cargo insurance. We were advised by Robert Bingaman that all I needed to do was complete and sign an "Exemption from PUC Cargo Insurance Regulations" form and fax it in to your office, which we did that same day (see enclosed). The agent asked Mr Bingaman if I was required to do anything else and he said "No, the signed exemption was all that was needed". I heard nothing else regarding this matter until this letter, dated Feb. 14, 2012. I feel that since I was told very plainly that nothing else was required on my part, I should not have to pay this fine.
