Utilities to supply the same clean fuel that, as I was told by plumbers that you do not have drip pipes, then tell U.G.I. to supply the same thing as you and other cities receive known as "America's clean fuel" to Hazleton, PA. And wherever U.G.I. has drip pipes, and do this without any price increases to the public. I only want what you are getting and that's not asking so much, and what you do not get: yellow chemical, health problems and a hazard to eyes seven months a year. We all need heat.
