Application of Interstate Gas Supply, Inc., dba IGS Energy, Inc. For Approval To Offer, Render and/or Furnish Natural Gas Supply Services as a Marketer/Broker Engaged In The Business Of Supplying Natural Gas Supply Services, To The Public In The Commonwealth Of Pennsylvania, Docket No. A-125051.

On April 7, 2009, IGS Energy, Inc. filed an application with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PUC") for a license to provide natural gas supply services as a broker/marketer engaged in the business of supplying natural gas.
