CERTIFICATION OF SATISFACTION

AND NOW comes Respondent Duquesne Light Company, by and through its attorney Jennifer L. Allison, and files this Certification of Satisfaction in accordance with Commission Regulation 5.24, 52 Pa. Code § 5.24:

1. The parties were able to reach a settlement on April 5, 2012.
2. In settlement of the Formal Complaint, Respondent will provide Complainant with a payment agreement whereby Complainant will pay the monthly budget amount plus \$20.
3. Respondent has agreed to provide Complainant with a \$100 credit to his account, which will be applied to the first payment of \$215 under the payment agreement. Complainant has agreed to make an initial payment of \$115 by May 10, 2012.
4. In order for this payment agreement to be established, Complainant agrees to be removed from Respondent's CAP program. In the future, if he continues to meet the requirements for the CAP program, he may apply for re-


enrollment either after he pays CAP arrears of \$1,146, or after one year has passed.

5. Complainants acknowledged that his Complaint was satisfied.
6. There is no need for further Commission action.


