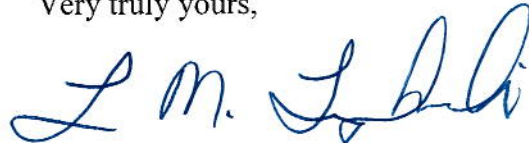

the Formal Complaint have been resolved, and the Complainants have indicated that they are satisfied and will not pursue the Complaint further.

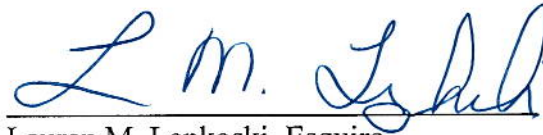
5. The Complainants have authorized the Company to file this Certificate of Satisfaction.
