**THE BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION AND ENFORCEMENT
MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE**

AND NOW comes the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (I&E) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission), by and through its attorney, Stephanie Wimer, and files this Motion for Continuance of the hearing in accordance with Section 1.15(b) of the Commission's regulations, 52 Pa. Code §1.15(b). In support thereof, I&E states as follows:

1. The above captioned Formal Complaint is scheduled for hearing before Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) John H. Corbett on Tuesday, May 8, 2012 at 10:00 a.m. in Pittsburgh.
2. Since the issuance of the Formal Complaint in this matter and up to the present time, I&E and the Yellow Cab Company of Pittsburgh (Respondent) have exchanged a number of correspondences and documents pertaining to the allegations set forth in the Formal Complaint.

3. Upon further investigation and the discovery of information from Respondent, I&E has determined not to proceed with a number of counts that are established in the Formal Complaint.
4. For this reason, I&E desires additional time to file an Amended Complaint and to allow Respondent with a meaningful opportunity to respond to the Amended Complaint.
5. Further, I&E and Respondent are diligently working to resolve this matter without litigation and request additional time to do so.
6. I&E requests that the hearing that is scheduled on May 8, 2012, be continued for an additional ninety (90) days with the anticipation that I&E and Respondent will reach an amicable resolution prior to the next scheduled hearing date.
7. Respondent has agreed to I&E's request to continue the hearing.

WHEREFORE, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement requests that the hearing in this matter be continued for ninety (90) days.


