AND NOW comes Respondent Duquesne Light Company, by and through its attorney Jennifer L. Allison, and files this Certification of Satisfaction in accordance with Commission Regulation 5.24, 52 Pa. Code § 5.24:


1. The parties were able to reach a settlement on June 6, 2012.
2. In settlement of the Formal Complaint, Respondent will provide Complainant with a payment agreement whereby Complainant will pay the monthly budget amount plus \$27.
3. In order for this payment agreement to be established, Complainant agrees to be removed from Respondent's CAP program. In the future, if he continues to meet the requirements for the CAP program, he may apply for re-enrollment either after he pays CAP arrears of \$961, or after one year has passed.
4. Complainant has agreed to pay \$85 by June 7, 2012.
5. The payment agreement will begin with the bill that is due in July.

6. As long as Complainant adheres to the terms of the payment agreement and pays the monthly budget amount plus \$27 each month, Respondent will not terminate his service for nonpayment.
7. Complainants acknowledged that his Complaint was satisfied.
8. There is no need for further Commission action.

WHEREFORE, Respondent requests that the Commission close its file on these matters.


