Applicant is seeking an increase in its hourly rates which have not been changed since June 30, 2008.

Also enclosed is an letter/affidavit signed by Thomas X. Liebtag, President of Lee's Moving & Storage, Inc. along with a copy of the 2011 Assesment Report - Motor Carriers. Eliminating the "exempt" shown on Line 2 the net revenues amount to \$465,482. Applicants 2011 revenues were less than \$500,000.
