By transmittal letter dated June 21, 2012, counsel for Integrity Transportation Services, LLC t/a Integrity Limousine ("Integrity"), filed with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Commission"), a second Petition for Reinstatement of its Certificate of Public Convenience for limousine authority issued on March 11, 2005, at Docket No. A-00121022, F.1. The first petition for reinstatement of Integrity filed on February 13, 2012, was denied by Opinion and Order entered April 26, 2012, due to an outstanding \$250 fine related to Docket No. C-2009-2097936.
