To Whom It May Concern:

On December 7, 2011, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement instituted a complaint against MM Transportation, LLC, alleging that, respondent, by failing to provide this Commission with a current list of all of his vehicles utilized under his limousine authority, violated 52 Pa. Code § 29.333(d).

Respondent was duly notified that, if no answer was filed within twenty (20) days from the date of service of the complaint, that either admitted or failed to deny the allegations of the complaint, the penalty would be imposed.

The complaint and notice were sent by certified mail on December 7, 2011, and served on respondent on December 14, 2011; and, more than twenty (20) days later, no response has been received from respondent.

Therefore, the allegations in the complaint are admitted and the complaint is sustained.

Respondent, within twenty (20) days from the date of the service of this letter, shall pay a fine of two-hundred dollars (\$250.00) by certified check or money order payable to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission at P.O. Box 3265, Harrisburg, PA 17105-3265, as provided in the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §§3301 and 3315, shall cease and desist from further violations of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §§101, et seq., and the Regulations of this Commission, 52 Pa. Code §§1.1, et seq.
