The Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (I&E) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission), by this letter, hereby amends the complaint in the above-captioned matter that was filed on June 18, 2012.

In the complaint, I&E asserted that Allied Medical Ambulance Service, Inc. (Respondent) owed the Commission \$27,366. Informal discovery revealed that a portion of Respondent's assessment was based on revenues earned from transportation services that do not fall under the Commission's jurisdiction.

I&E amends its complaint to reflect that Respondent owes an assessment balance of \$6,500. In addition, I&E amends the complaint to withdraw any civil penalty associated with Respondent's unpaid assessment.

Upon payment of this amount, \$6,500, I&E will file a certificate of satisfaction, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §5.94(a), certifying that Respondent has satisfied the complaint and requesting that the case be marked closed.
