Page (7) Add (5)


Relief

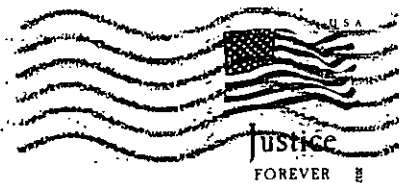
