


To whom it may concern:

I have had the same insurance agent for several years that I know personally. I receive a letter every year for as long as I remember, PUC saying they have not received my renewed insurance. And every year I make the same phone call to PUC, fax copy, and have my insurance agent mail another copy. This year PUC sent a certified letter (I never received). Please see copy from United Postal Service. On May 18, 2012, the mail man brought the certified letter but I was not home to sign. On May 19, 2012, I talked to the mail man and he did not have it, he called the postmaster and could not find the letter. I had no idea who the letter was from. If you could please look at my insurance history with PUC since April of 2000, I have always had insurance. On June 12, 2012 I called PUC immediately, they said to respond with a letter, I did. Then I received a letter on June 19, 2012 saying the suspension was lifted (nothing about a fine) on June 28, 2012. I received another letter saying I never responded to the first letter, and that I have a \$500.00 fine. If I never responded how could PUC send me a letter, lifting my suspension on June 19, 2012. I am sending a copy of all letters received. Could you please take this matter into consideration and wave the fine.

To Whom It May Concern:

On May 7, 2012, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement instituted a Complaint against Gary C. Walk Jr., t/a Walks Moving, Respondent, alleging failure to maintain evidence of liability insurance on file with this Commission, a violation of the Public Utility Code at 66 Pa C.S. §512, 52 Pa. Code §32.2(c), and 52 Pa. Code §32.11(a), §32.12(a) or §32.13(a).

In accordance with 52 Pa. Code §5.61, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement notified the Respondent that, unless its insurer files evidence of insurance with this Commission and Respondent pays the proposed fine, Respondent must file an Answer to the Complaint within twenty (20) days of the date of service. The Notice further specified that, if Respondent failed to answer the Complaint within twenty (20) days, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement would request the Commission issue an Order that imposes a penalty, which could include a fine, cancellation, or any other remedy.

The Complaint was served on the Respondent on May 12, 2012. To date, more than twenty (20) days later, Respondent has failed to file an Answer to the Complaint. On June 15, 2012, the Respondent's insurer filed evidence of insurance effective on April 1, 2011, however, Respondent has failed to pay the fine.

Therefore, the allegations in the Complaint are admitted and the Complaint is sustained.

Respondent shall pay a fine of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for failure to maintain evidence of insurance on file with this commission, 52 Pa. Code §32 within twenty (20) days from the date of this letter. Payment must be by certified check or money order, payable to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, P.O. Box 3265, Harrisburg, PA 17105-3265, as provided in the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §§3301 and 3315.


