Written Procedure Regarding the Use of Vouchers (As of August 2, 2012)

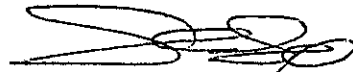
It is the intent of Yellow Cab Company of Pittsburgh (“Yellow Cab”) to at all times fully comply with the provisions of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code, as amended (“PUC Code”) and the requirements of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“PUC”). Incident to said objective, Yellow Cab hereby states the following written procedure (the “Procedure”) regarding the use of taxi travel vouchers (the “Voucher”) authorized and approved by third parties (“Third Party”) for call or demand transportation of an individual (the “Passenger”):

1. The Third Party will contact Yellow Cab for the transportation of the Passenger (the “Trip”), authorizing that the specific trip shall be undertaken at the request of the Third Party and shall be paid by the Third Party via voucher;
2. The driver of the Yellow Cab call or demand taxi vehicle (the “Driver”) who accepts the voucher trip shall provide to Yellow Cab a voucher in the format included as Exhibit A to this Procedure document (the “Voucher”) containing the following information pertaining to the transportation of the Passenger:
 - a. The date of the Trip;
 - b. The times and places of origin and destination (i.e., street address) pertaining to the Trip;
 - c. The meter fare for the Trip;
 - d. The name(s) of the passenger(s) transported;
 - e. The Driver’s name, I.D. Number, and Car Number; and
 - f. The name of the representative of the Third Party authorizing the Trip.
3. Once the Voucher is processed by Yellow Cab, the fare (the “Fare”) shall be based solely upon the actual “door to door” meter tape based upon the Yellow Cab tariff plus a tip (the “Tip”) as set forth below. The Third Party will be billed the Fare by Yellow Cab on an intermittent basis as mutually determined by the Third Party and Yellow Cab. In addition, the Third Party and Yellow Cab will mutually determine a specified Tip percentage for each Trip that can be added to the Fare, said Tip to be subject to revocation by the Third Party if the circumstances dictate.

4. As per the Plan for Alternative Form of Compensation approved for use by the Yellow Cab Company, all Voucher trips shall be tracked as per the Mobile Data Meter System, or paper log sheets, whichever is applicable.

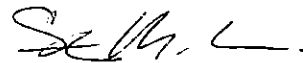
