In Re: Request for permission to use vehicles more than eight (8) model years old.

Dear Carl W. Hovenstine:

I have reviewed the information that you submitted for permission to use three vehicles in your call or demand service that are more than eight (8) model years old.

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 29.314(d), vehicles operated in call or demand service in Pennsylvania may be no more than 8-model years old, unless otherwise permitted by the Commission. By Order entered June 1, 2007, the Commission clarified the procedure, *inter alia*, that a carrier may use to seek an exemption to the 8-year limitation. Petition of the Pennsylvania Taxi and Paratransit Association, Docket No. P-00072274 (Order entered June 1, 2007). In that Order, the Commission approved the procedural and substantive guidelines established by the Bureau, noting that the guidelines are not substantive rules but rather "provide guidance on the [Bureau's] interpretation of our regulation regarding the vehicle age requirement and the process by which the exception requests will be evaluated."

Information has revealed that Pauls Cab Service, Inc. is not in compliance with the Commissions regulations. Records reflect that the fine for complaint C-2010-2206738 was due by April 20, 2011 and has not been paid. As indicated in the written letter dated June 22, 2012, waivers to regulations will not be considered unless the applicant is in compliance, including assessment and fine payments.

Please be reminded that no vehicle more than eight (8) model years old may be used in public utility service without having obtained a waiver certificate from the Commission.

Finally, pursuant to the Commission's June 1, 2007 Order, this Bureau decision can be appealed, as of right, to the Commission within 20 days of the date of this letter.

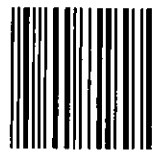
