ANSWER

Respondent, Germantown Cab Company, by through its attorney, Michael S. Henry, Esquire, herby responds to the complaint in the above matter, as follow:

Since the complaint does not contain numbered paragraphs, Respondent denies the allegations of the Complaint generally as conclusions of law to which no response is required. By way of further answer, Respondent is without information sufficient to form a belief as to the truth or falsity of the averments in this paragraph; therefore the same are denied and strict proof is demanded at the time of hearing.

By way of further answer, Respondent asserts that, in light of the recent amendments to Chapter 57 of the Parking Authorities Law enacted as part of Act 119 of 2012, the Commission no longer has jurisdiction or regulatory authority over Respondent. See 53 Pa. C.S. §5714(d)(2), as amended.
