
Recently I received a certified letter stating that a complaint had been filed against me by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, Bureau of Investigation & Enforcement, stating that I was in violation of the commission for failure to provide evidence of insurance on file with the commission.

As of April 15, 2012 the last Tri-Axle Dump Truck, running under my PUC authority was sold, prompting an earlier retirement than originally planned. The state of the economy, forever rising costs, increased taxes, fuel and the lack of work all contributed to my decision to sell. After futile attempts to notify the Utility Commission, I notified my insurance company, Daily Underwriters of America of the sale of my Tri-Axle, prior to the end of the month, before my next insurance bill would be due in May, 2012. The insurance spokesperson informed me they would notify the PUC of my cancellation of my insurance. I have always been above board with the running of my business, and have always tried to do things the legal way, so this complaint comes as a slap in the face on top of a \$300.00 fee I was forced to pay to my insurance company for cancelling and not giving a 90 day notice. You sent me a letter cancelling my PUC authority, so I am not quite sure why this complaint was filed. You can not insure something you do not have.

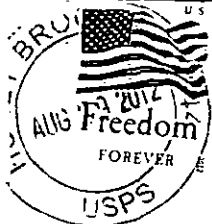
