

NAMING

RATES, RULES AND REGULATIONS

GOVERNING

THE RIGHT

1. To transport, as a Class D carrier, household goods and office furniture, in use, between points in the city and county of Philadelphia.
2. To transport, as a Class D carrier, household goods and office furniture, in use, from points in the city and county of Philadelphia to other points in Pennsylvania within an airline distance of fifty (50) statute miles of the Philadelphia City Hall, and vice versa:

subject to the following condition:

That no right, power or privilege is granted to transport, pianos, radios and refrigerators, except as part of a household move, from one location to another.

SECTION 1
RULES AND REGULATIONS

ITEM 10 - GOVERNING PUBLICATIONS

For rates, rules, regulations and provisions applicable to the transportation of HOUSEHOLD GOODS and RELATED ARTICLES, IN USE, except as otherwise provided herein, see Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 53 (Carrier Directory), loose-leaf revisions thereto and successive issues thereof, issued by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc., Agent.

ITEM 20 - DECLARED VALUE (A)

Rates and charges named herein applicable when value declared by shipper does not exceed sixty (60) cents per pound per article. For method of determining rates when declared value exceeds sixty (60) cents per pound per article, see Governing Tariff.

ITEM 30 - PACKING AND UNPACKING

Packing and unpacking will be performed on an hourly basis plus the cost of containers (Item 100), and such labor will be charged at labor rates shown in Section 3, Items 300 or 350, whichever applicable herein.

ITEM 40 - CLASSIFICATION OF PROPERTY (C)

Class 1 Shipments are personal effects and property usual in a dwelling when a part of the equipment or supply of such dwelling; and articles, including displays and exhibits, which because of their unusual nature or value require specialized handling and equipment usually employed in moving household goods which are not described in Class 2 Shipments.

SECTION 2
ADDITIONAL SERVICE CHARGES

ITEM 100 (Concl'd) (A)

PACKING CONTAINER CHARGES (When furnished to shipper by carrier)

Rates are in dollars and cents per each unit, except as noted.

B. OTHER

(a) Wardrobe rental cartons \$8.00 each.

Tote carton rentals \$1.50 each for duration of move.

C. PICKUP/DELIVERY OF PACKING MATERIAL (C)

When shipper requests carrier to deliver packing material prior to move, or if shipper requests carrier to pickup packing material after completion of move (other than the date of the move) the following charge will be assessed in addition to all other lawful charges contained herein.

\$100.00 per pickup/delivery

SECTION 3
HOURLY RATES

ITEM 300 (A)

Applicable on the transportation of CLASS 1 SHIPMENTS (Item 40) transported distances forty (40) miles and less.

Subject to Notes 1 to 6 below, the transportation charge on any shipment shall be a COMBINATION of the applicable TRAVELING CHARGE named in Note 5 plus HOURLY CHARGE at applicable rates named in Columns 2, 3 and 4.

Hourly rates apply only from time of arrival of vehicles and men at first point of origin (continue during all loading, transportation from first point of origin to final destination, and unloading) until completion of unloading and dismissal of vehicles and men by shipper at destination.

Traveling charges cover traveling to first point of origin and traveling from final destination, irrespective of actual time involved in such traveling.

Note 1 - Traveling charges (Note 5) are in addition to hourly rates (Columns 2, 3 and 4).

Note 2 - Hourly rates (Columns 2, 3 and 4) are based on the day or days, as indicated during which services are performed.

Note 3 - Hourly rates (Columns 2, 3 and 4) are computed in half-hour periods; fractions of one-half hour considered one-half hour.

Note 4 - Rates in Column 3 apply only from 5:01 P.M. to 12:00 midnight on any day when a higher rate is shown for the following day.

Note 5 - A flat charge based on the applicable transportation rate shown in Columns 2, 3 and 4 will be assessed to cover traveling charges to and from the job.

- Over 0 not over 10 miles 1/2 hour
- Over 10 not over 20 miles 1 hour
- Over 20 not over 30 miles 1-1/2 hours
- Over 30 not over 40 miles 2 hours

Note 6 - Minimum charge: four (4) hours at rates named in Columns 2, 3 or 4.
