In regards to file number C-2012-2320463 I have set forth the following facts:

1. My business ceased operations on May31, 2012 when the Pennsylvania Apportioned registration on my vehicles used in the business expired. This can be verified with the Department of Transportation in Harrisburg.
2. My business filed for bankruptcy protection in June of 2012.
3. My liability insurance was valid until August of 2012, so I was insured three months after the fact that I ceased operations.
4. In August of 2012 I received a letter from the Public Utility Commission informing me of the insurance problem. I called the phone number on the paper sent, explained the circumstances and the end result of shutting the company down on an answering machine and never received a response until the registered letter sent on September 04,2012.
5. Additionally in August I visited the Public Utilities web site looking for a form or some sort of instructions as to what to do in the case of not needing the authority anymore. I went to the Transportation and Safety section, then proceeded to the motor carrier section and went to forms and applications. The only thing I found in this section was the Abandonment of service form, but it states it is only to be used if you are a small passenger or household goods carrier which I am neither. I have enclosed a copy of this to reference what I am talking about. The commission's web site was ineffective in guiding me in this circumstance.
6. Consequently I ask that the commission possibly wave the \$ 500.00 fee being imposed on me because no illegal activities were intentionally committed.

Application Descriptions

- Abandonment of Service** - For small passenger and household goods carriers Only (\$10 filing fee)
- Airport Transfer Carrier** - (\$350 filing fee)
- Contract Carrier** - Transports employees/passengers for a specific company or companies (\$350 filing fee)
- Emergency Temporary Carrier** - (\$350 filing fee)
- Experimental Passenger Carrier** - (\$350 filing fee)
- Group and Party Carrier** - Charter bus, tour and special excursion operators of vehicles seating between 11 and 15 passengers, including the driver (\$350 filing fee)
- Group and Party Carrier** - Charter bus, tour and special excursion operators of vehicles seating more than 15 passengers, including the driver (\$100 filing fee)
- Household Goods Broker** - Household goods in use broker (\$350 filing fee)
- Household Goods In Use Carrier** - Household goods in use carrier (\$350 filing fee)
- Limousine Carrier** - (\$350 filing fee)
- Paratransit Carrier** - (\$350 filing fee)
- Passenger Broker** - (\$350 filing fee)
- Property Carrier** - Excluding household goods in use (\$100 filing fee)
- Scheduled Route Carrier** - (\$350 filing fee)
- Taxi Carrier** - (\$350 filing fee)
- Transfer of Rights** - For small passenger and household goods carrier (\$350 filing fee)

Application Approval

Property Carriers and Group & Party Service

This includes charter bus, and tour and special excursion operators operating vehicles seating more than 15 including driver.

- Proof of insurance (52 Pa. Code 32.11 - 32.15) is required to be filed within 60 days of approval. (75 Pa. C.S. 1701 1799.7)
- Satisfactory completion of a safety fitness review (52 Pa. Code, Chapter 37) is required within 180 days of approval.

Household Goods in Use and Passenger Carriers

Includes taxi, limousine, airport transfer, paratransit (van service), group & party when operating vehicles seating 15 or less including driver, and scheduled route bus service.

- Approval time depends on protest filed subsequent to application being published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*.
- Proof of insurance (52 Pa. Code 32.11 - 32.15) is required to be filed within 60 days of approval. (75 Pa. C.S. 1701 1799.7) See [Motor Carrier Insurance](#).

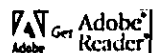
Additionally, household goods carriers must satisfactorily complete a safety fitness review and review of household goods customer service standards (52 Pa. Code. 31.121 130) within 180 days of approval.

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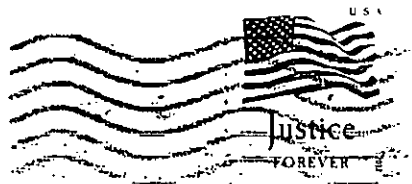
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
