

Please be informed that when a prospective shipper requests moving service and before an order for service is prepared, the household goods carrier shall furnish the prospective shipper with a statement titled "Information for Shippers" as required by 52 Pa. Code \$31.121(a), of which the bottom part has to include the signature of the shipper, the dates certified that the information for shippers was furnished to this person and the signature of the carrier representative. The carrier shall retain a copy of this certification with the shipping order.

The following ten (10) moves reflect violations of 52 Pa. Code §31.122(2), for failure to use and execute a proper form for estimates of charges titled "Estimated Cost of Service":

The shipper shall be given a complete estimate of charges on the proper form as required by 52 Pa. Code §31.122(2), even if a verbal estimate is given over the telephone in advance.

The following move reflects a violation of 66 Pa. C.S. §1303, by charging a greater rate than that specified in your tariff at Tri-State households tariff at Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 51, on file with this Commission:

> (a) In the household good move made for Julia Goldblatt on February 1, 1996, you charged \$373.60, as opposed to the correct charge of \$370.00, resulting in an approximate overcharge of \$3.60.

Continued operations, as described above, may subject you to penalties which may include the assessment of fines up to \$1000 per violation, as well as the suspension of your vehicle registration.


