#### ORDER

#### BY THE COMMISSION:

William C. Stumpf, t/d/b/a Stumpf Moving and Storage Company (Carrier) furnishes household goods in use services in Allegheny County, as thoroughly described in the order granting authority at Docket No. A-00099993.

Carrier has filed 4<sup>th</sup> revised page 101, 2<sup>nd</sup> revised page 102, and 2<sup>nd</sup> revised page 103 to Freight PA PUC No. 54 on January 31, 2011.

Carrier proposes to increase its move of 40 miles and less hourly rate for a compliment of three men and vehicle for Saturdays by 9.1%, for Sundays and Holidays by 5.7%, and for days other than Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays by 5.1%. Carrier currently charges \$137.30 per hour on Saturdays and proposes an increase to \$149.75 per hour. Carrier's current Sundays and Holidays rates per hour are \$162.25, with a proposed increase to \$174.65 per hour. Lastly, Carrier's present rates for days other than Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays are \$95.00 per hour, with a proposed increase to \$99.80 per hour. The current hourly rates have been in effect since October 23, 2000.

Carrier is also proposing to increase its line haul charges for moves in excess of 40 miles, as well as increases in packing container charges. Those rates have been in effect since April 19, 2005.

Carrier has submitted a tariff and documentation, in compliance with 52 Pa. Code §23.67(c), for carriers of household goods in use, with gross annual intrastate revenues of less than \$200,000 and an operating ratio of not less than 93%.

#### **ANALYSIS**

In order to generate this revenue increase, carrier proposes to increase its hourly three men and vehicle normal complement charge as well as its line haul charges and container fees. The carrier submitted a statement that its revenues from intrastate operations are less than \$200,000, and its operating ratio is not less than 93%.

#### CONCLUSION

We have determined that the increase is not an excessive amount based on the operating ratio. We believe that the increase will be sufficient to provide safe, dependable and continuous service to the public. The Carrier has no outstanding fines or assessment due; THEREFORE,

#### IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. That the 4<sup>th</sup> revised page 101, 2<sup>nd</sup> revised page 102, and 2<sup>nd</sup> revised page 103 to Freight PA PUC No. 54 be approved to become effective on May 9, 2011.
