3. The applicant is an agency of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, organized and existing under the Administrative Code of 1929, 71 P.S. § 511, et. seq. and generally 36 P.S. § 670 - 401 et. seq.
4. This application covers the removal of the existing structure and the construction of a new structure over the Railroad on a slightly new alignment.

6. SR 6011 crosses, above the tracks of the Delaware-Lackawanna railroad at Segment 0190, Offset 0452 . The ADT for SR 6011 is 15,466 vehicles with 3% trucks.
7. The funding for this project will be 80% Federal Funds and 20% State Funds. (The funding for construction will be 80% federal funds)
8. This project is necessary and proper for the safety and convenience of the public.

9. A field conference of all parties of interest should be held to discuss the proposed relocation.



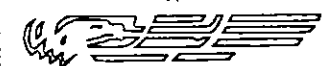
