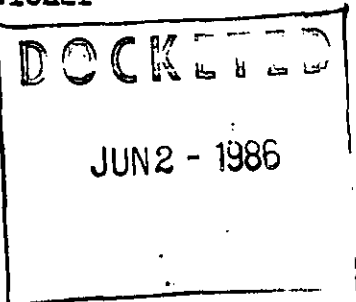
(a) Application of Towaway Express, Inc., Mechanicsburg, Cumberland County, for emergency temporary authority, to transport, as a common carriers (excluding mobile homes, travel trailers and office trailers), trailer chassis, trailer converter dollies, and containers, leased by McDonnell Douglas Finance Corporation to Hall's Motor Transit Company, for the account of Chicago Fleet Liquidators, from points in Pennsylvania, to the facilities of Dupes' Garage, Londonderry Township, Dauphin County.

(b) The application for emergency temporary authority was filed May 16, 1986, with a permanent authority application broader in scope than the instant application, having been filed earlier. The applicant seeks emergency temporary authority to transport trailers that were leased by McDonnell Douglas Finance Corporation to Hall's Motor Transit Company. The applicant has demonstrated that there exists an immediate need for the transportation of said trailers due to the closing of a number of terminal operated by Hall's. The record contains sufficient evidence to demonstrate that an emergency situation exists which would warrant a grant of emergency temporary authority.

(c) The Bureau of Transportation recommends that the Commission adopt the proposed order, approving the application granting emergency temporary authority for a period of thirty (30) days from the date the order is adopted.

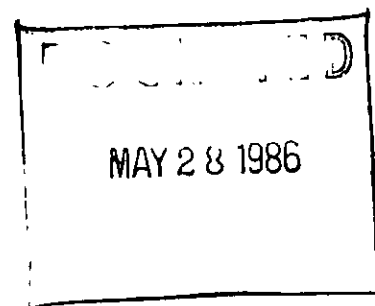
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O R D E R

BY THE COMMISSION:

This matter comes before the Commission on an application for emergency temporary authority filed May 16, 1986. An application for permanent authority, broader in scope than the instant application, has also been filed.

The applicant, Towaway Express, Inc. (applicant or Towaway), 6780 Carlisle Pike, Mechanicsburg, Cumberland County, seeks a grant of emergency temporary authority for thirty (30) days that would permit the transportation of trailers. The trailers to be transported had been leased to Hall's Motor Transit Company (Hall's) by the McDonnell Douglas Finance Company (McDonnell). The trailers in question are to be transported by the applicant at the direction of John F. Dupes, Dupes' Garage,

Middletown, who has been designated the agent to retrieve, store and hold for sale on behalf of McDonnell Douglas Finance Corporation and Chicago Fleet Liquidators. The trailers are located at Hall's Pennsylvania terminals and shipper locations throughout Pennsylvania. The applicant will also be transporting trailers from points outside of Pennsylvania to Middletown.

McDonnell requires the services of the applicant immediately so as to permit the removal of the trailers from terminals of Hall's, since these terminals are to be closed as the result of Hall's bankruptcy proceedings. There are in excess of 250 trailers located in Pennsylvania of which more than 50 are ready for transportation to Middletown. Towaway has been requested to provide the proposed transportation due to the fact that it possesses two unique tractor units which permit the transportation of two 28 1/2 foot trailers in tandem.

Having reviewed all things pertinent to the instant proceeding, we have determined that the applicant has demonstrated that an emergency situation exists which would create an immediate need for service.

We find:

1. That the applicant has demonstrated that an emergency situation exists; THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED: That the application for emergency temporary authority be and is hereby approved, granting the following right:

To transport, as a Class D carrier, trailers (excluding mobile homes, travel trailers and office trailers), trailer chassis, trailer converter dollies and containers, leased by McDonnell Douglas Finance Corporation to Hall's Motor Transit Company, for the account of Chicago Fleet Liquidators, from points in Pennsylvania, to the facilities of Dupes' Garage, Londonderry Township, Dauphin County.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the emergency temporary authority granted herein is effective immediately for a period of thirty (30) days from the date the order is adopted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That approval of the emergency temporary authority application shall have no bearing on the application for permanent authority.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the applicant shall file a tariff establishing just and reasonable rates within ten (10) days of the date the order is entered.

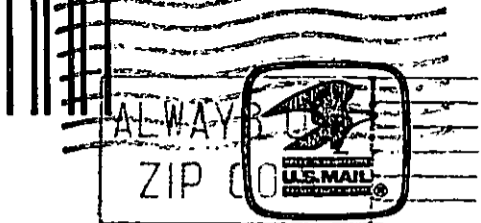
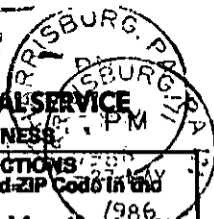

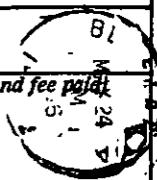
