Dear Mr. Engelbrecht:

Per our telephone conversation today during the mediation call, this letter confirms that you will not proceed with the above-referenced Public Utility Commission (PUC) Complaint. As the parties desire to amicably resolve the dispute without the need for further litigation, PECO Energy has agreed to resolve your formal complaint as follows:

- (1) Your security deposit has been refunded to you in the amount of \$257.75. This amount was calculated as follows (\$300.00 deposit - \$54.87 gas/electric + 12.62 interest).
- (2) The security deposit was mailed to your last mailing address 14 Beaver Hill Road, Horsham, PA 19044, on October 19, 2012 at check number 00002288771.
- (3) Regulatory Assessor, Charles Thomas, sent you email correspondence on October 24, 2012 to kengelbrecht738@comcast.net advising of the status of your deposit refund.

This letter memorializes the entire agreement between Klaus D. Engelbrecht and PECO Energy Company. Any other terms or promises, written or oral, not in the body of this letter will not be a part of this settlement agreement and, therefore, will be void.

I will also forward a Certificate of Satisfaction to the PUC to inform them of the status of this complaint. Unless you file a written objection to the PUC within ten (10) days, the Certificate of Satisfaction will sufficiently confirm to the PUC that the Complaint has been resolved and the file will be closed.
