Spectrotel of Pennsylvania, LLC will provide facilities-based local telephone exchange service by purchasing network elements from underlying local carriers via Interconnection Agreement and/or Commercial Agreement. The Applicant will provide resold interexchange services by reselling the telecommunications services of facilities-based long distance carriers. At this time, the Applicant does not propose to construct its own facilities in Pennsylvania.

11. **SERVICE AREA:** Describe the geographic service area in which the Applicant proposes to offer services. Spectrotel of Pennsylvania, LLC. proposes to offer services in the same service area currently authorized for Spectrotel, Inc. This includes interexchange services statewide and local exchange services in exchanges served by Verizon Pennsylvania LLC; Verizon North LLC.; Frontier Commonwealth Telephone Company d/b/a Frontier Communications Commonwealth Telephone Company, LLC; Frontier Communications of Breezewood, LLC; Frontier Communications of Canton, LLC; Frontier Communications of Lakewood, LLC; Frontier Communications of Oswayo River, LLC; and Frontier Communications of Pennsylvania, LLC .

Spectrotel, Inc. proposes to market its services to residential customers and small and medium business customers and may extend its services in the future to larger business customers throughout the proposed service areas.

Spectrotel of Pennsylvania, LLC will be operating as a detariffed IXC Reseller; therefore, an IXC reseller tariff will not be included. The Company understands that detariffed IXCs remain subject to Pennsylvania laws. Please see *Exhibit B* for the CLEC and access tariffs. These tariffs are identical to the current CLEC and access tariffs currently on file for Spectrotel, Inc. in Pennsylvania. The only changes that have
