FIRST INTERIM ORDER

At today's hearing, Ms. Delaney raised an issue not appearing in her complaint: that she contacted The Peoples Natural Gas Company, d/b/a Dominion Peoples (Peoples) about a security deposit letter a week before moving to Florida for three months to help her husband who was working there. According to Ms. Delaney, the Peoples representative told her she would receive a bill before she moved to Florida and could avoid paying the security deposit if she paid the bill promptly. Ms. Delaney did not receive the bill before moving to Florida and ended up paying the security deposit. The parties agreed to a 30-day continuance so Peoples can determine if its files contain notes of the alleged conversation. By December 15, 2005, I will receive from counsel for Peoples a certificate of satisfaction or a request for further hearing.

THEREFORE,


IT IS ORDERED:
