TAKE NOTICE:

That a complaint in the above entitled matter, of which the attached is a true and correct copy, has been presented and filed of record with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission. Section 702 of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. Section 702, requires the Commission to serve on each party named in a complaint a copy of the complaint and notice calling upon each party to satisfy the complaint, or to answer the same in writing within a specified time; THEREFORE,

1. You have twenty (20) days from the date on which this complaint is served to either satisfy this complaint or to file with the **Secretary of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, P. O. Box 3265, Harrisburg, PA 17105-3265**, an answer (original and two copies), in writing, under oath, which, as required by Section 5.61 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 52 Pa. Code Section 5.61, either affirms or specifically denies the allegations in this complaint. You must also serve a copy of the answer upon the complainant. The date of service is the mailing date as indicated by the date at the top of this Notice. Section 1.56(a) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 52 Pa. Code Section 1.56(a).

2. If you fail to either satisfy this complaint or to file answer or other responsive pleading within twenty (20) days, you will be deemed to have admitted all the allegations in this complaint in accordance with Section 5.61 of the Commission's Rules of Administrative Practice and Procedure, 52 Pa. Code Section 5.61. In that event, the Commission may, without hearing, enter an order which either revokes or suspends any certificate or permit held by you or which imposes a fine or any other appropriate penalty or remedy authorized by the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. Section 101, et seq.; and, if you are a customer of a utility, an order may be entered which

prescribes a payment schedule or which authorizes termination of utility services. The Commission is not limited to the relief sought by the complainant in paragraph 4 of the attached complaint.

3. If you elect to satisfy this complaint you must file, within twenty (20) days from the date on which this complaint is served, affidavits executed by each complainant that this complaint has been satisfied. Such affidavits must describe the basis on which this complaint was satisfied; any settlement agreement between the parties must be reduced to writing and attached to the affidavit. Such affidavits are to be filed with the Secretary of the Commission at the address set forth in paragraph 1. Upon receipt of affidavits of satisfaction from all complainants, this complaint may be dismissed by the Commission in accordance with Section 703(a) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. Section 703(a), unless the Commission determines that such dismissal would be contrary to the public interest, in which event the Commission may direct that hearings be held upon the complaint.

4. If you file an answer which admits the allegations in this complaint, or which fails to specifically deny the allegations in this complaint, the Commission may, without hearing, enter an order which either revokes or suspends any certificate held by you or which imposes a fine or any other appropriate penalty or remedy authorized by the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C. S. Section 101, et seq.; and, if you are a customer of a utility, an order may be entered which prescribes a payment schedule or which authorizes termination of utility services. The Commission is not limited to the relief sought by the complainant in paragraph 4 of the attached complaint.

5. If you file a timely answer which specifically denies the allegations in this complaint, or which raises material questions of law or fact, this matter shall be referred to the Office of Administrative Law Judge for hearing and decision. If, after hearing on the issues raised by that answer, you are found to have committed any of the violations alleged in the complaint, the Administrative Law Judge may render a decision which either revokes or suspends any certificate or permit held by you or which imposes a fine or any other appropriate penalty or remedy authorized by the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C. S. Section 101, et seq.; and, if you are a customer of a utility, an order may be entered which prescribes a payment schedule or which authorizes termination of utility services. In the imposition of a penalty after a hearing the Administrative Law Judge is not bound by the relief sought by the complainant in paragraph 4 of the attached complaint.

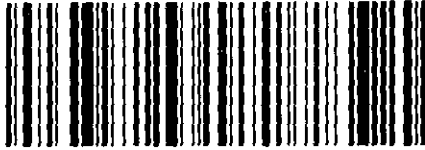





ANSWER and NEW MATTER TO COMPLAINT

TO: THE PENNSYLVANIA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION

AND NOW, comes the Respondent, Equitable Gas Company (Equitable) by its attorneys Yukevich, Marchetti, Liekar & Zangrilli, P.C. and the undersigned counsel and files this Answer and New Matter to the Complainant's Formal Complaint filed in the above captioned case:

1. The allegations of Paragraph 1 of the Complaint are admitted.
2. The allegations of Paragraph 2 of the Complaint are admitted.
3. The allegations of Paragraph 3 of the Complaint are admitted.
4. The allegations of Paragraph 4 of the Complaint are denied.

By way of further answer and defense, Ms. McCollum is the owner and ratepayer of record at 1262 Blackadore Avenue, Pittsburgh, PA 15221 from January 15, 2004 to June 4, 2004. Ms. McCollum is disputing an estimated bill she received for gas service from January 15, 2004 to February 12, 2004. Equitable obtained an initial actual meter reading on January 15, 2004 when Ms. McCollum was placed into billing. An actual meter reading was also taken on March 12, 2004 and was subsequently verified by another actual meter reading on March 15, 2004.

These readings indicated the previously estimated bill was estimated too high. Accordingly, Equitable cancelled the charge of \$778.32 and credited this amount to Ms. McCollum's account. Ms. McCollum was then rebilled for the period of January 15, 2004 to March 15, 2004 in the amount of \$939.01.

Equitable attempted to undertake a high bill investigation on March 15, 2004, but there was no access. Equitable mailed Ms. McCollum a utility report on April 7, 2004 advising her that we were unable to complete the investigation and requesting that she contact Equitable to reschedule it.

In further answer to the allegations, Complainant has failed to provide any documentation or other evidence to support its claims and, therefore, Respondent cannot provide any further response other than to state that the Complainant remains liable for the account since it ordered, accepted and benefited from the natural gas products and services for which it has been invoiced.

5. The allegations of Paragraph 5 of the Complaint contain a prayer for relief to which no response is required. To the extent that a response is required and/or deemed necessary, it is Respondent's position that the Complainant is fully responsible for all charges on this account since it ordered, accepted and benefited from the natural gas products and services for which it has been invoiced.

6. After reasonable investigation, Equitable is without sufficient information or knowledge to form a belief as to the truth of the allegations contained in Paragraph 6 of the Complaint.

7. The allegations of Paragraph 7 of the Complaint are admitted.

WHEREFORE, the Respondent, Equitable Gas Company, respectfully requests that the subject Complaint be dismissed with prejudice.


8. Paragraphs 1 through 7 inclusive of Respondent's Answer are incorporated herein as though set forth more fully at length.


