A-9 As required in Docket # R-2010-2171918, TESI-Treasure Lake Water Division submitted the Company's quarterly iron and manganese tests results, chlorine test results and customer complaint information for the quarterly period July 1, 2012 through September 30, 2012. Provide Aqua's immediate and future plans to address these water quality and service issues and related customer complaints. Attached is TESI's most recent quarterly compliance filing.

Response: Aqua's immediate and future plan to address water quality and service issues and related customer complaints is to acquire the system and, after gaining operating knowledge, determine necessary improvements and a time frame and cost estimate for moving forward. Tentatively, Aqua anticipates that improvements to the water system may include main replacements (includes associated fittings, company service lines, fire hydrants and related appurtenances); upgrades to treatment facilities; meter replacements or upgrades; security; and the installation of automation and controls to remotely monitor the tank and well/treatment of the System as explained in the response to data request A-4.
