Please accept this letter as a "reply comment" to the comment that PECO submitted to the Pennsylvania Utility Commission (PUC) in a letter dated November 28, 2012.


We applaud PECO's commitment to ensure that customers with ITINs (Individual Tax Identification Numbers) fully participate in the CAP program as stated in Footnote 3 on Page 23, of PECO's November 28, 2012 comment to amend its Universal Service and Energy Conservation Plan for 2013-2015.

ITINs are federal tax ID numbers that the US Internal Revenue Service (IRS) issues to immigrants who cannot obtain Social Security numbers.

We remain concerned about PECO's requirement that applicants to the CAP program must present a tax ID to apply for the program but are heartened by PECO's willingness to work with clients, advocates, community based organizations and public interest entities to reconsider CAP applications that PECO denies because a client cannot provide a tax ID number.
