

**PREHEARING MEMORANDUM
OF THE DUQUESNE INDUSTRIAL INTERVENORS**

The Duquesne Industrial Intervenors ("DII") hereby submit this Prehearing Memorandum in the above-captioned proceeding. DII intends to participate in this proceeding as an "active" party.

I. HISTORY OF THE PROCEEDING

On November 15, 2012, Duquesne Light Company ("Duquesne") filed with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PUC" or "Commission") a Petition for approval of its Act 129 Phase II Energy Efficiency and Conservation ("EE&C") Plan ("Petition"). Through the Petition, Duquesne identifies and describes its programs to be implemented to achieve the additional consumption reduction targets imposed by the Commission's Phase II Implementation Order entered August 3, 2012, at Docket Nos. M-2008-2069887 and M-2012-2289411 ("Implementation Order").

The Prehearing Conference for the instant proceeding will be held on December 10, 2012. Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") Dennis J. Buckley is the presiding officer.

DII submits this Prehearing Conference Memorandum in compliance with the ALJ's Prehearing Conference Order.

II. ANTICIPATED ISSUES AND SUB-ISSUES

DII is still in the process of evaluating the Company's Petition, however, after a preliminary review, DII members are concerned with the proposed Phase II EE&C costs and programs that would impact the terms and conditions of members' electricity service. Specifically, DII members are concerned with respect to any rate increases imposed as a result of the Company's EE&C Phase II Plan. DII anticipates pursuing these issues during this proceeding, presenting any appropriate evidence related to these issues, and reserves the right to address further issues and to respond to all matters raised by other parties.

III. PROPOSED WITNESSES

DII is in the process of evaluating whether it will sponsor testimony in this proceeding. In the event that DII decides to sponsor testimony, it will inform the parties and the ALJ as soon as possible of the intended witness(es) and topics of testimony. DII also intends to participate in this proceeding through the submission of discovery, the cross-examination of other parties' witnesses, participation in settlement negotiations as they occur, and the submission of briefs, exceptions and reply exceptions, as necessary.

IV. PROPOSED SCHEDULE AND DISCOVERY RULES

DII will work with the parties to develop an appropriate procedural schedule. DII will cooperate to develop discovery rules in accordance with the Commission's regulations and any ALJ directives.

V. POSSIBILITY OF SETTLEMENT

DII is willing to participate in discussions with the other parties to amicably resolve the issues in this proceeding.
