TENTH INTERIM ORDER

On February 2, 1998, counsel for the Commission's Office of Trial Staff informed me that the parties were experiencing difficulty in complying with that provision of the Ninth Interim Order concerning the mandatory format for tables to be appended to their briefs. Specifically, the approved format for the tables assumed this application would be presented upon a revenue requirement basis, when, in fact, the parties presented their cases using a margin or net book value basis. In order to resolve any problems this conflict posed, an informal telephonic conference was held at 2:00 p.m. on that date after facsimile notice to all parties. During the conference, all parties attending agreed upon a format for these tables as Duquesne Light Company proposed with certain revisions. Following the hearing, Duquesne Light Company revised its proposed format for these tables as agreed upon at the conference and served its revised proposal upon the parties and the presiding Administrative Law Judge.

Since it now appears all interested parties agree to the revised proposal of Duquesne Light Company for the proper format for these tables, the revision is hereby approved and it replaces the earlier table format. In lieu of the table format ordered to be used in the Second Prehearing Order and the Ninth Interim Order, the parties are hereby directed to use the



format for these tables as it appears in Appendix A, which is attached to this Order. **If a party makes a claim regarding any of the information required by these tables and does not submit the requisite table in the format appearing in Appendix A, that claim will be ignored.** The Commission, its staff, the technical reviewing staff and the presiding ALJ do not have the time and resources to discover how a party derives its claim, unless that information is provided in the table format requested. For that reason, use of these tables in this format is mandatory for a party submitting a claim regarding any of the information required by these tables.

In addition, the parties are permitted to footnote their entries on these tables and/or supply separate schedules in more detail, provided they utilize the tables in the format directed by this Order. The parties must cite their entries on these tables to the record. Also, the parties must indicate whether the values they claim on these tables are either pre-tax or net of tax, where applicable. Finally, parties having difficulty filling out the "Company Claim" column on the tables should refer to Duquesne Light Company's Exhibit DJC-10, which is attached to Mr. Clayton's Rebuttal Testimony.

In all other respects, the directions for preparation and filing of briefs as outlined in the Ninth Interim Order issued January 23, 1998 remain unchanged.
