

OPINION AND ORDER OF CHAIRMAN JOHN M. QUAIN

On June 22, 1998, Citizen Power, the Mon Valley Unemployed
Committee, the Group Against Smog and Pollution, the Pennsylvania Public
Interest Group, Citizens Organizations on Utility Policies, Just Harvest, the
Alliance for Progressive Action and Clean Water Action ("Citizen Power") filed
an unverified Petition for Recusal and for Further Discovery ("Petition"), in which
they seek to have me recuse myself from all further proceedings in the above-
captioned matters. The basis for the motion is the receipt, by Robert A. Rosenthal
of my staff, of a document from Frank M. Nadolny, the director of regulatory

affairs for Duquesne Light Company, which is attached to the Petition as Attachment 1. In addition to my recusal, Citizen Power seeks discovery on the events surrounding receipt of the memo, and requests that the Commission institute an investigation into the matter.

The Nadolny memo, dated May 6, 1998, was received by Mr. Rosenthal after the Commission unanimously adopted a Joint Motion at public meeting on April 30, 1998 for disposing of Duquesne's restructuring proceeding. Subsequently, an Order consistent with that Motion was adopted by the Commission at public meeting on May 21, 1998 and thereafter entered on May 29, 1998. Presently pending before the Commission is a Petition for Clarification or Reconsideration of the May 29, 1998 Order filed by Duquesne on June 16, 1998, as well as a Petition for Reconsideration of Hospital Shared Services and Administrative Resources, Inc. I note that various reconsideration petitions are also pending before the Commission in connection with the West Penn restructuring proceeding and the DQE/AYP merger application case.

The immediate question before me is whether receipt of the Nadolny memo by Mr. Rosenthal warrants my recusal from any further participation in the adjudication of the Duquesne restructuring proceeding, as well as the other two related matters. Based upon my review of the factual circumstances, as well as the

law governing recusal and ex parte communications, I am completely confident of my impartiality to participate in deciding the merits of these cases.

Most of the law of recusal has developed in the judicial rather than the regulatory context. However, it is equally applicable to judges and to Commissioners performing a quasi-judicial function as adjudicators. In reaching a decision on the motion, I utilize the full body of recusal law, regardless of whether particular principles originated in a regulatory or judicial forum.

The Supreme Court of Pennsylvania has said that, upon receipt of a motion for recusal, “the judge [has the duty] to decide whether he feels he can hear and dispose of the case fairly and without prejudice...” Reilly By Reilly v. Southeastern Pennsylvania Transportation Authority, 507 Pa. 204, 489 A.2d 1291, 1300 (1985). Other courts have dictated that, “it is the judge’s duty not to sit when he is disqualified. It is equally his duty to sit where there is no valid reason for recusation.” Andrews et al. v. General Insurance Company, 418 F. Supp. 304 (W.D. Oklahoma 1976); Edwards v. United States, 334 F. 2d 360 (5th Cir. 1954).

The standard for reviewing such a motion has been enunciated by the courts. “First, the affidavit must state facts with sufficient particularity. Only the facts contained therein are relevant, not conclusions.” United States v. Thomas, 299 F. Supp. 494, 499 (E.D. Missouri 1968); see also Reilly by Reilly, 489 A.2d at 1299-1300. Further, “[a] party who petitions for recusal bears the burden of

producing evidence that establishes bias, prejudice, or unfairness.” Rizzo v. Haines, 520 Pa. 484; 555 A.2d 58 (1989).

The actual facts alleged in the unverified petition are limited to the existence of the Nadolny memo, the thrust of which, according to Citizen Power, “was that the Chairman’s motion contained the wrong figures for the amortized return of taxes.” Petition at 2. Citizen Power contends that the Nadolny memo constitutes an *ex parte* communication and that it “has and/or will cause it prejudice in these proceedings.” Petition at 5. Citizen Power fails, however, to assert the existence of any evidence which “establishes bias, prejudice, or unfairness.” In fact, Citizen Power has not suggested that the communication in any way affected my position or the outcome of this proceeding.

Section 319(a)(3) of the Public Utility Code directs each Commissioner to “[a]void all *ex parte* communications prohibited in this part.” 66 Pa.C.S.

§319(a)(3). *Ex parte* communications are defined in Section 334 as follows:

(c) Ex parte communications - Ex parte communications prohibited in this section shall mean any off-the-record communications to or by any member of the commission, administrative law judge, or employee of the commission, regarding the merits or any fact in issue of any matter pending before the commission in any contested on-the-record proceeding.

66 Pa.C.S. §334(c). Section 319(a)(5) of the Public Utility Code further explicitly mandates that each Commissioner “require staff and personnel subject to his

direction to observe the standards of fidelity and diligence that apply to the commissioner...” 66 Pa.C.S. §319(a)(5).

Upon becoming aware of the memo on June 23, 1998, I immediately instructed the Law Bureau to conduct an independent investigation concerning the events surrounding the memo and whether it constituted an ex parte communication. The Law Bureau has advised that it is clear that the Nadolny memo was not an effort to influence me to change my decision on the substantive issues addressed in the April 30, 1998 Motion adopted by the Commission in the Duquesne restructuring proceeding. Indeed, the Law Bureau concluded that there was no request that the substance of that Motion be altered. Rather, the memo simply documented alleged inconsistencies between the content of the Motion and the methodologies used by the Commission to make the complex calculations necessary to implement the Motion. Stated otherwise, the memo suggested that the numbers shown in the tables accompanying the Motion did not match the words used in the Motion. As such, the memo did not constitute an ex parte communication “regarding the merits or any fact in issue.”

Furthermore, the memo addressed four computational issues,¹ which are included among the issues that Duquesne raises in its Petition for Clarification or

¹ These issues relate to: (1) whether Duquesne’s proposed roll-in of the Energy Cost Rate was factored into the Commission’s calculation of a system average bundled rate for 1999, (2) whether distribution line losses were removed twice in calculating a distribution revenue requirement, (3) the calculation of a 1996 total

Reconsideration, now pending before the Commission.² That Petition was served on all parties, and such service gave those parties an opportunity to respond to Duquesne's assertion that the Commission made ministerial errors in the numerical calculations embodied in the Order of May 29, 1998. It is noteworthy that in answers filed by the Office of Consumer Advocate and the Duquesne Industrial Intervenors to Duquesne's Petition for Clarification (both of whom were active consumer representatives during the restructuring proceeding), they characterize Duquesne's assertions as highlighting corrections of numerical computations, the details of which should be resolved through the compliance filing.

Therefore, I am convinced that the parties to the Duquesne restructuring proceeding have been afforded an ample opportunity to comment on the computational issues initially raised by the Nadolny memo and subsequently asserted in Duquesne's Petition for Clarification. Nevertheless, to absolutely assure that the impartiality of the Commission on this issue cannot be reasonably questioned, I have directed the Secretary of the Commission to serve all parties

² Following issuance of the Commission's May 29, 1998 Order, Duquesne sought to meet with staff regarding these same issues. Upon advice from the Law Bureau, the Commission refused to permit staff members to meet with Duquesne, and directed that Duquesne be advised to raise the matter in a Petition for reconsideration or clarification.

with the Nadolny memo, and give them an opportunity to respond to its content independent of any response they might have to the Petition for Clarification. By Letter dated June 24, 1998, the Secretary served this communication on all parties to the proceeding and indicated that interested parties may file comments on or before July 2, 1998.³

In Blue Mountain Consolidated Water Co. v. Pa. P.U.C., 57 Pa.

Commonwealth Ct. 363, 426 A.2d 724 (1981), the Commonwealth Court addressed the issue of ex parte communications. In that case, a member of the then-Chairman's staff communicated with two members of the Bureau of Rates staff, one of whom testified in Blue Mountain's rate case. The Chairman sent a memorandum detailing the conversation to all parties in the case and made the document part of the record. The Court held that the conversation was a prohibited off-the-record communication regarding the merits of the case. However, service of the explanatory memo on all the parties, which provided Blue Mountain the opportunity to respond, "removed the taint of prejudice." 426 A.2d at 726. Similarly, service of the Petition for Clarification or Reconsideration and service of the Nadolny memo on all parties to

³ I note that the communication served by the Secretary on the parties includes all of the attachments that were received by Mr. Rosenthal with the May 6, 1998 Nadolny memo, rather than only the "deferred tax calculation" document appended to Citizen Power's Petition. It was through those additional attachments that the other computational issues were originally identified by Duquesne.

the proceedings removes any taint of prejudice emanating from the memo, even if it had been an ex parte communication.

Upon a review of the facts and the law, I have concluded that it is not necessary or appropriate for me to recuse myself from participating in the adjudication of these three matters. The Nadolny memo did not constitute an ex parte communication, particularly since it made no attempt to affect the Commission's resolution of the substantive issues. However, to protect the integrity of the agency, I have directed that it be served on the parties to provide them with an opportunity to respond.

Moreover, I was personally unaware of the existence or content of the Nadolny memo until this Petition was filed and I am not biased or prejudiced against, or in favor of, one party or another in these cases. Further, I have not prejudged the matters contained in the memo or the Petition for Clarification, nor do I believe that my conduct, or that of any staff member has reasonably created the appearance of prejudice or unfairness.⁴

I will continue to treat all parties in these proceedings with impartiality and fairness. In an abundance of caution, I have insulated myself from contact with Mr. Rosenthal regarding these cases. Specifically, I have not had occasion to


⁴ Indeed, as Citizen Power points out in its petition, the memo was apparently received by Mr. Rosenthal prior to the issuance of the Order which Duquesne Light seeks to revisit. Yet, the Final Order remained consistent with the details of the Commissioners' Joint Motion of April 30, 1998.

consult with Mr. Rosenthal about the merits or any alleged computational errors involved in these cases since the issuance of the May 29, 1998 Orders⁵, and I will not consult with him in the future about these matters.

Finally, I deny the request of Citizen Power for discovery regarding the events surrounding receipt of the memo. Based on my conclusions about the nature of the communication and the subsequent events affording all parties ample opportunity to respond to the content of the entire communication, I do not believe that any further discovery is warranted. I am, however, directing the Law Bureau to conduct an investigation of the matter, and to provide its findings to the Commission in a public report; THEREFORE:

IT IS ORDERED that the Petition of Citizen Power for Recusal and for Further Discovery is granted in part and denied in part consistent with this Opinion.

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
