(b) By Opinion and Order entered on May 29, 1998, the Commission directed Duquesne to file a generation divestiture plan. On August 27, 1998, Duquesne filed its Generation Auction Plan. On October 14, 1998, Duquesne amended its plan to include the transfer of generating and transmission assets between Duquesne and FirstEnergy Corporation. By Order entered on November 19, 1998, the Commission, *inter alia*, denied System Council U-10, IBEW's Motion to Suspend the Proceeding. On December 18, 1998, the Commission issued an Opinion and Order addressing the issues and comments filed by the Parties in the instant proceeding. On January 4, 1999, the Environmentalists filed a Petition for Clarification and Reconsideration. On January 4, 1999, a Petition for Reconsideration, Modification, and Clarification was filed by System Council, U-10, IBEW, and Local 272, IBEW.

OPINION AND ORDER

Before the Commission for consideration are two (2) Petitions for Reconsideration, Modification and Clarification relative to our Opinion and Order entered in the above-captioned proceeding on December 18, 1998.

On May 21, 1998, the Commission approved an Order in the Duquesne Light Company (Duquesne or Company) electric restructuring proceeding which established various requirements to be followed by Duquesne in the event of a divestiture of some/all of its generations assets. *See Application of Duquesne Light Company for Approval of its Restructuring Plan Under*

Section 2806 of the Public Utility Code (Restructuring Order), Docket No. R-00974104, (May 29, 1998).

On August 27, 1998, Duquesne filed its Generation Auction Plan pursuant to the Commission's directive in our *Restructuring Order*. Subsequently, on October 14, 1998, Duquesne amended its Plan to include the transfer of generating and transmission assets between Duquesne and FirstEnergy Corporation.

On November 6, 1998, Local 272, International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW), the representative of employees at FirstEnergy's Mansfield generating station, filed a Petition to Intervene and Comments.

By Opinion and Order entered December 18, 1998, the Commission approved the Company's Generation Auction Plan consistent with the findings in that Order. Subject to the requirement that Duquesne provide the Commission with periodic updates of the progress of the auction, the Commission approved the auction protocols set forth in the Plan. We noted that the generation exchange with FirstEnergy as set forth in the Agreement in Principle¹ appeared to be in the public interest. (December 18, 1998 Order, slip op. at 15). The Commission expressly authorized the Duquesne to proceed with an auction of the FirstEnergy plants it will receive in the exchange subject to reporting on the due diligence results and specific terms of the final agreement.

¹ In an October 14, 1998 Letter to the Commission's Secretary, Duquesne informed the Commission and all Parties of Record that it had entered into an Agreement in Principle with FirstEnergy to exchange its ownership interest in all of its jointly owned plants for three FirstEnergy plants.

On January 4, 1999, two (2) Petitions for Reconsideration, Modification and Clarification were filed in this proceeding. Specifically, System Council U-10, IBEW (System Council) and Local 272, IBEW (Local 272) filed a Petition requesting that the Commission amend its December 18, 1998 Order to: (1) grant the Petition to Intervene of Local 272; (2) modify or clarify the Commission's finding that the generation exchange with FirstEnergy Corporation is in the public interest; and (3) establish definite filing deadlines before the Commission makes a final ruling (and permits Duquesne to proceed beyond the solicitation of interest from potential bidders phase) with respect to whether the auction is in the public interest.

In its Petition, the Environmentalists request that we reconsider and clarify our December 18, 1998 Order by specifically outlining all of the issues (16) which Duquesne should address before we issue a final Order approving the generation exchange and the auction. The Environmentalists also request that the Commission provide an explicit sequence of steps for Duquesne to follow with regard to the generation exchange and revisit three concerns with the generation exchange's transmission provisions.

Upon review of the Petitions filed by the System Council/Local 272 and the Environmentalists, we conclude that the substantive issues raised by these Parties do not warrant reconsideration or clarification. In our view, the Petitioners have not raised any "new and novel arguments" not previously heard or considerations which appear to have been overlooked or not addressed by the Commission. *Duick v. Pennsylvania Gas & Water Company*, 56 Pa. P.U.C. 553 (1982). Rather, the critical issues relating to the approval of Duquesne's

Generation Auction Plan were fully considered by the Commission in our December 18, 1998 Order. *See Slip op.*, pp. 17-19.

We note, however, that although in our December 18, 1998 Order, we considered the Comments filed by Local 272, we neglected to formally grant its Petition to Intervene. The record indicates that no Party has opposed Local 272's intervention in this proceeding. In view of the interests of Local 272 in this matter, we shall amend our December 18, 1998 Order solely for the purpose of granting Local 272's request for intervention. In all other respects, the Petitions for Reconsideration are denied; **THEREFORE**,


IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the Petition for Reconsideration, Modification, and Clarification filed by System Council U-10, IBEW, and Local 272, IBEW on January 4, 1999, relative to the December 18, 1998 Opinion and Order in the above-captioned proceeding is denied consistent with this Opinion and Order.

2. That the Petition for Clarification and Reconsideration filed by the Environmentalists on January 4, 1999, relative to the December 18, 1998 Opinion and Order in the above-captioned proceeding, is denied.

3. That the Petition to Intervene filed by Local 272, International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers on November 6, 1998 is granted, nunc pro tunc.
