





Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.71 et seq., PPL Electric Utilities Corporation ("PPL" or the "Company"), by its attorney, hereby files this Petition to Intervene in the above-captioned proceeding involving the Petition of Duquesne Light Company ("Duquesne") for approval of a plan for post-transition period Provider of Last Resort ("PLR") service. In support of its Petition, PP&L states as follows:

1. PPL is an Electric Distribution Company ("EDC") providing electric services in central eastern Pennsylvania, subject to the jurisdiction of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PUC" or the "Commission"). PP&L's principal

3. On June 30, 2000, Duquesne submitted a proposal to the PUC addressing its PLR obligation during the period between completion of the company's transition period and December 31, 2004. Duquesne's proposal includes, inter alia, creation of new levelized shopping credits, rules to address customers returning for PLR service only during high-cost months, and an extension of Duquesne's rate caps.

4. On September 15, 2000, the PUC entered an order in this proceeding. The Commission held in abeyance until its Public Meeting of September 28, 2000, consideration of Duquesne's petition. The Commission also directed that within 10 days from the entry of its order, parties may submit written responses addressing the acceptability of a collaborative approach in this proceeding and provide the waivers necessary for Commissioners to participate as facilitators in the collaborative.

5. PPL has direct and substantial interests in this proceeding that cannot adequately be represented by any other party. Inasmuch as the outcome of this proceeding could create a template for the post-transition plans of other EDCs, PPL may be directly affected. To the extent that the Commission determines that an

extension of the rate cap into a post-transition period is appropriate, PL's interests would be affected. Furthermore, PL has a direct interest in the development of a policy to address the "seasonal gaming" of PLR service by customers switching to PLR service during high cost periods. To the extent this proceeding addresses that issue, PPL could be directly affected. Finally, PPL is participating in the Commission's PLR working group to develop appropriate rules and procedures for providing PLR service after the end of the transition period. The efforts of the Commission's working group may be affected by the outcome of this proceeding. Therefore, PPL's participation as an active party in this proceeding is required to protect its substantial individual interests.

6. Each of the parties participating in this case will take positions on the issues that support its specific interests, and those positions may be inconsistent with the positions that PPL would take. For this reason, no other party in this proceeding can adequately represent PPL or protect the Company's interests.

7. In response to the Commission's September 15, 2000 order, PPL hereby states that, if its petition to intervene is granted, a Commission-sponsored collaborative effort is acceptable to the Company. In addition, PPL hereby agrees to waive any objections to the voting on the instant petition, or any subsequent proceedings regarding this matter by those Commissioners who participate as facilitators in the collaborative.

WHEREFORE, for all of the foregoing reasons, PPL respectfully requests that the Commission grant this petition and approve PPL's intervention as an active party of record in this proceeding.
