PUBLIC STATEMENT OF THE CONSUMER ADVOCATE
ISSUED IN ACCORDANCE WITH 71 P.S. §309-4(e)

Act 161 of the Pennsylvania General Assembly, 71 P.S. § 309-2, *et.seq.*, as enacted July 9, 1976, authorizes the Consumer Advocate to represent the interests of consumers before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“PUC” or “Commission”). In accordance with Act 161, and for the following reasons, the Consumer Advocate determined to file a Notice of Intervention and participate in proceedings before the Commission involving the Application of Duquesne Light Company (“Duquesne”).

On December 22, 1999, Duquesne filed an Application with the Commission seeking a certificate of public convenience authorizing the transfer of its ownership interests in seven electric generation stations and related transmission assets to Orion Power Holdings (“Orion”). The Application is being made as part of the divestiture of Duquesne’s generation assets to Orion pursuant to the recently concluded Generation Auction. Orion, as winning bidder, has agreed to pay Duquesne \$1.705 billion and has also agreed to provide wholesale power supply to Duquesne for the service of Duquesne’s provider of last resort (“POLR”) customers.

The instant Application seeks Commission approval and the issuance of a certificate of public convenience for Duquesne to transfer to Orion its interests in the following generation stations: Cheswick, Elrama, Brunot Island, Phillips, Avon Lake, New Castle and Niles. The assets being transferred to Orion include the three generation stations acquired from FirstEnergy Corporation as part of the Generation Exchange approved by the Commission’s July 15, 1999 Order in Docket No. R-00974104. Duquesne is also seeking to transfer certain transmission facilities (i.e., generator step-up transformers, generator leads, and switchyard facilities) that are associated with the plants. In addition, Duquesne will obtain from Orion the wholesale supply of power necessary to serve Duquesne’s POLR customers. In exchange for the above consideration, Orion will pay Duquesne \$1.705 billion.

The actual market value of Duquesne's generation assets, as determined by the results of the Generation Auction, will be used to adjust the administrative determination of stranded cost that Duquesne is recovering through its Competitive Transition Charge ("CTC"). The CTC will be adjusted to reflect the results of the Generation Auction.

The OCA files this Notice of Intervention in order to ensure that the relief sought by this Application is (1) found to be in the public interest; (2) in accordance with the Public Utility Code and prior Commission Orders; and (3) does not adversely affect the customers of Duquesne Light Company.


