
MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE

AND NOW comes the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (I&E) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission), by and through its attorney, Heidi L. Wushinske, and files this Motion for Continuance in accordance with Section 1.15(b) of the Commission's regulations, 52 Pa. Code §1.15(b). In support thereof, I&E states as follows:

1. The above-captioned Formal Complaint was served on UGI Utilities, Inc. (UGI) on November 28, 2012.
2. On December 13, 2012, UGI notified I&E that it would be satisfying the demands set forth in the Formal Complaint.
3. The parties have been engaged in ongoing settlement discussions.
4. I&E requests a continuance until January 4, 2013, to facilitate further discussions.
5. This is the first extension sought by Complainant in this matter and is unopposed by the Respondent.


