**MOTION FOR DEFAULT JUDGMENT**

NOW COMES the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's ("Commission") Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement ("I&E"), by its counsel, and files this Motion for Default Judgment against Family Transport Services, Inc. ("Respondent") pursuant to Section 5.103 of the Commission's regulations, 52 Pa. Code §5.103. In support thereof, I&E respectfully represents as follows:

1. I&E commenced this action on September 26, 2012 by filing a Complaint and serving it by certified mail.
2. Attached to the Complaint was a Notice advising Respondent that it must file an Answer within twenty (20) days of service of the Complaint.
3. The Notice also advised Respondent that if it failed to answer the Complaint, I&E would request that the Commission issue an Order imposing the penalty set forth in the Complaint.
4. On October 4, 2012, Respondent signed a receipt confirming that it received the Complaint. A true and correct copy of proof of delivery of the Complaint is attached as Exhibit 1.
5. The twenty (20) days to file an Answer to the Complaint expired on October 24, 2012.

6. I&E's Complaint requested that Respondent pay its outstanding assessment balance of \$723 and a civil penalty of \$1,100 for failing to file an assessment report and pay the assessment on time.
7. To date, Respondent has not filed an Answer to the Complaint.
8. To date, Respondent paid \$783 towards the amount requested in the Complaint. A balance of \$1040 remains.

WHEREFORE, I&E respectfully requests that the Commission enter a Default Order against Respondent that orders Respondent to pay the remaining amount requested in I&E's Complaint.


