

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**Section 5 - SERVICE OFFERINGS****5.1 GENERAL**

Local Service provides a customer with a connection to the Company's network which enables the customer to:

- a. place and receive calls from other stations on the public switched telephone network;
- b. access the Company's local calling service;
- c. access the Company's operators and business office for service related assistance; access toll-free telecommunications services such as 800 NPA; and access 911 service for emergency calling; and
- d. access the service of providers of interexchange service. A customer may presubscribe to such provider's service to originate calls on a direct dialed basis or to receive 800 service from such provider, or may access a provider on an ad hoc basis by dialing the provider's Carrier Identification Code (10XXX).

**5.2 RESIDENTIAL LOCAL SERVICE**

Residential Local Service provides the customer with an access line and usage within a local calling area for the transmission of two-way interactive switched voice or data communications. Local Calling Areas are described in Section 8.1 of this Tariff.

The Company's services are furnished subject to the availability of facilities and equipment, and are subject to the terms and conditions of this Tariff.

Residential Local Service is offered as a stand-alone local offer or in conjunction with an associated long distance service provided by the Company.

Residential Local Services are subject to monthly recurring charges and service charges on a per access line basis, as specified following.

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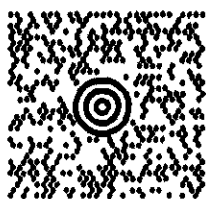

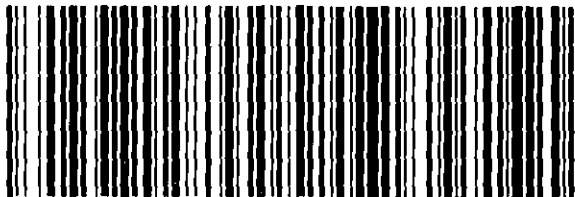


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
