

**PREHEARING CONFERENCE MEMORANDUM
OF EGS PARTIES**

NOW COME, Interstate Gas Supply, Inc. d/b/a IGS Energy (“IGS”) and Dominion Retail, Inc. d/b/a Dominion Energy Solutions (“DES”) (collectively “EGS Parties”), by and through their counsel, in the above-captioned matter, Hawke, McKeon & Sniscak, LLP, and hereby submit this Prehearing Conference Memorandum in anticipation of the Prehearing Conference currently scheduled for Tuesday, January 15, 2013, at 10:00 a.m. before the Honorable Cynthia Williams Fordham, Presiding Administrative Law Judge.

The EGS Parties have actively participated in the above-captioned default service plan matter, and as electric generation suppliers licensed to operate in the PECO service territory, both have an interest in allowing all customers to shop and choose an electric generation supplier. Accordingly they have a direct interest in the outcome of the above-captioned matter, and will be bound by any Order issued by the Commission as an outcome of this proceeding.

I. DISCOVERY

1. At this point, the EGS Parties do not expect to conduct discovery in this matter, but if they do, they will adhere to any schedule or plan advised by the Parties to this proceeding.

II. SETTLEMENT

2. The EGS Parties are willing to discuss settlement of this matter on amicable terms at any juncture. In the EGS Parties' opinion, an agreed-upon resolution in this type of matter is desirable.

III. ISSUES

3. The EGS Parties believe that the primary issue for resolution in this case whether CAP customers will have the ability to participate actively in the competitive electric generation supply market and under what terms and conditions they will be allowed to do so.

IV. AMOUNT OF HEARING TIME NEED

4. If a hearing eventually proves to be necessary in this matter, the EGS Parties do not anticipate the need for more than a single day of hearings; unless an extraordinary and unanticipated number witnesses are presented or the issues expand greatly.

V. WITNESS

5. The EGS Parties are still evaluating whether it would necessary or appropriate for them to call a witness in this matter. If they do, they will provide notice to Your Honors and the Parties as soon as possible following such identification.

VI. SCHEDULE

6. The EGS Parties will cooperate with the other Parties to this matter to develop a schedule that is acceptable to all Parties and Your Honor.


