BY THE COMMISSION:

Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc. (Tristate) has filed a 10th Revised Page 82 to Tariff Freight Pa. PUC No. 50 on June 30, 2006 and proposes a total increase in revenues of \$34,652 to cover increased wage and fringe benefit expenses for carriers in York County. The current rates have been in effect since December 24, 2002.

Tristate proposes to increase the hourly 3 men and vehicle normal complement charge by 9.7%. The current hourly rate for York County is \$103 per hour. Tristate proposes increasing this rate to \$113 per hour.

Warners Motor Express, Inc. and Leonard-Wherly Moving Systems are the affected carriers that are subject to the 9th Revised Page 82 to Tariff Freight Pa. PUC No. 50 for York County.

Tristate has submitted a wage/fringe benefit cost study for York County in support of the proposed hourly increase indicating that the increase is necessary to cover the cost of operating. Employee wages and fringe benefits have increased by an average of 46% from \$15.90 per hour in 2002 to \$23.25 per hour in 2006.

ANALYSIS

In order to generate a revenue increase of \$34,652, Tristate proposes to increase the 3 men and vehicle normal complement by 9.7% from a charge of \$103 per hour to \$113 per hour. We conclude that the data compiled in the wage/fringe benefit cost study submitted by the carriers support this increase.

CONCLUSION

We have determined that Tristate has submitted the documentary justification to support the proposed revenue increase of \$34,652 and that the increase is not an excessive amount based on the increase in operating expenses. We believe that the increase will be sufficient for the carriers to provide safe, dependable and continuous service to the public: THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. That 10th Revised Page 82 to Tariff Freight Pa. PUC No. 50 is approved to become effective September 18, 2006.
- 2. That a copy of this order be served upon Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc.
