Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Enclosed herewith are three (3) copies of Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No.4 cancelling Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 3, issued by Bayshore Transportation Systems, Inc. with one (1) set for scanning and two additional tariffs for Mr. Robert Bingaman in the Bureau of Technical Utility Services file. This tariff is being filed in compliance with the requirements of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Law.

The proposed tariff is being filed seeing increases and reductions in its hourly rates as well as increases and reductions in its packing, unpacking and container rates.. The latter apply to both under and over 40 mile transportation service of household goods in use. The hourly rates apply solely to the under 40 mile transportation service of household goods in use.

Also enclosed is a photocopy of the 2011 Assessment Report prepared by Bayshore in a timely manner. This is a copy that was not officially filed with your Commission. Checking with the Assessment Department will surely confirm these revenues and fully executed. Please note that the revenues shown on this attachment reflects only household goods in use revenues for 2011.

Lastly, attached is a signed affidavit stating by Bayshore Transportation Systems, Inc. that its 2011 operating revenues were less than \$500,000 and its operating ratio was not less than 93%.



SECTION I
RULES AND REGULATIONS

ITEM 10 - SCOPE OF CARRIER'S OPERATING AUTHORITY •

Rates and provisions named in this tariff or as amended, are limited in their application on Pennsylvania intrastate commerce to the extent of the operating rights set forth below.

Folder 2

To transport, as a Class D carrier, household goods in use, between points in the counties of Chester and Delaware, and from points in said counties, to points in Pennsylvania.

Folder 2, Am-A

To transport, as a common carrier, household goods in use:

- (1) between points in the city and county of Philadelphia and within an airline radius of five (5) statute miles of the Philadelphia City Hall in the county of Montgomery;
- (2) between points in the city and county of Philadelphia and within an airline radius of five (5) statute miles of the Philadelphia City Hall in the county of Montgomery, to other points in Pennsylvania within an airline radius of fifty (50) statute miles of the Philadelphia City Hall and vice versa;
- (3) between points in the city and county of Philadelphia;
- (4) from points in the city and county of Philadelphia, to points in Pennsylvania, and vice versa;
- (5) between points in the city of Chester, Delaware County, and within five (5) statute miles of the usually traveled highways of the limits of said city;
- (6) between points in the county of Delaware, and from points in said county, to other points in Pennsylvania, and vice versa; and
- (7) between points in the city of West Chester, Chester County, and within an airline distance of ten (10) statute miles of the limits of said city, and from said area, to points in Pennsylvania, and vice versa;

SECTION I
RULES AND REGULATIONS

ITEM 20 - GOVERNING PUBLICATIONS •

For rates, rules, regulations and provisions applicable to the transportation of HOUSEHOLD GOODS IN USE, except as otherwise provided herein, see Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 53 (Carrier Directory No. 53), loose-leaf revisions thereto and successive issues thereof, issued by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc. Agent.

ITEM 30 - CLASSIFICATION OF PROPERTY •

Class 1 shipments are personal effects and property used or to be used in a dwelling when a part of the equipment or supply of such dwelling and such other similar property; except that this subparagraph shall not be construed to include property moving from a factory or store, except such property as the householder has purchased with the intent to use in his dwelling and which is transported at the request of, and the transportation charges paid to the carrier by the householder.

ITEM 40 - DECLARED VALUE ♦

Rates and charges named herein, applicable when value declared by shipper does not exceed sixty (60) cents per pound, per article. For method of determining rates when value declared exceeds sixty (60) cents per pound, per article, see Governing Tariff.

ITEM 50 - OVERNIGHT S.I.T. •

Where storage-in-transit shipment is not unloaded at carrier's warehouse, and shipment remains on carrier's vehicle, an overnight storage-in-transit (S.I.T.) flat charge of \$150.00 per vehicle will be assessed.

Waiting charge will be assessed by carrier on the basis of a vehicle, driver and two helpers at the applicable hourly rates shown in tariff from 8 A.M. following overnight S.I.T. flat charge until carrier's employees and equipment arrive at customer's location for unloading. Thereafter, carrier's hourly rates shown in tariff will be assessed based on the equipment and labor furnished by carrier from the commencement of unloading until completion of unloading and dismissal of equipment and labor by shipper.

SECTION III
HOURLY RATES

ITEM 300

Applicable to the transportation of Class 1 Shipments (Item 30) transported distances of forty (40) miles and less.

Subject to Notes 1 to 7 below, the transportation charges on any shipment shall be a COMBINATION of the applicable TRAVELING CHARGE named in Column 1 plus HOURLY CHARGE at applicable rates named in Columns 2, 3 and 4.

Hourly rates apply only from time of arrival of vehicles and men at first point of origin (continue during all loading, transportation from first point of origin to final destination, and unloading) until completion of unloading and dismissal of vehicles and men by shipper at destination.

Traveling charges cover traveling to first point of origin and traveling from final destination, irrespective of actual time involved in such traveling.

Note 1 - Traveling charges (Column 1) are in addition to hourly rates (Columns 2, 3 and 4).

Note 2 - Hourly rates (Columns 2, 3 and 4) are based on the day or days as indicated, during which services are performed.

Note 3 - Hourly rates (Columns 2, 3 and 4) computed in half-hour periods; fraction of one-half hour considered one-half hour.

Note 4 - When a holiday falls on a Saturday, the rates named in Columns 1 and 2 shall be applicable.

Note 5 - Minimum total transportation charges:

Four (4) hours at rates named in Columns 1 and Columns 2, 3, and 4.

Note 6 - Carrier will supply and charge for supervisor or supervisors as requested by shipper. Rate for each supervisor will be computed from time of arrival of vehicles and men at first point of origin until completion of unloading and dismissal of vehicles and men at final destination unless other time of arrival or dismissal of supervisor is provided by agreement between shipper and carrier.

Note 7 - Traveling charge will be based on one (1) hour at the applicable rates shown in Columns 2, 3 or 4.

ITEM 400 •

Rates apply on Class 1 Shipments (Item 30) transported distances in excess of forty (40) miles.
