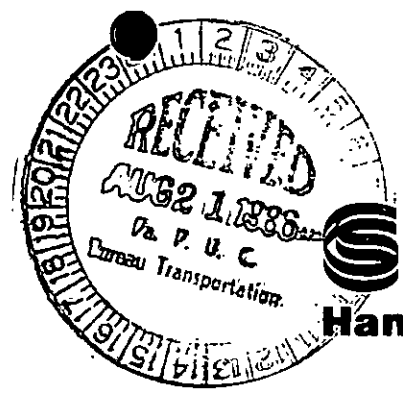

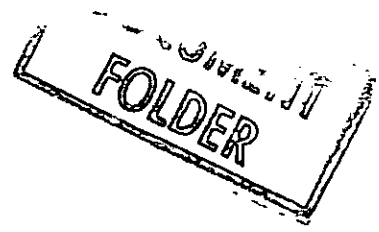

DECREE

AND NOW, July 23 , 1986, upon consideration of the Petition of Curt Stricker for Appointment of a Temporary Guardian of the Estate and a Temporary Guardian of the Person of Donald Freiler, an alleged incompetent, and it appearing to the Court that Donald Freiler is presently incapacitated, mentally and physically, due to a stroke and is confined to the Lewistown Hospital in Lewistown, Mifflin County, Pennsylvania; it appearing further that Donald Freiler is unable to communicate with other persons and, consequently, is unable to manage or supervise his business affairs, to attend to his property interests or to communicate with his attending physicians and sign consent forms for his medical care and treatment; and it appearing further that irreparable harm to the Person or Estate of Donald Freiler may and probably will result if Temporary Guardians of his Estate and Person are not appointed.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to Section 5513 of the Probate,

Estates and Fiduciaries Code, 20 Pa. C.S.A. 5513, Hamilton Bank, Reading, Berks County, Pennsylvania, is appointed Temporary Guardian of the Estate of Donald Freiler and Curt Stricker, of R.D. #1, Leesport, Berks County, Pennsylvania, is appointed Temporary Guardian of the Person of Donald Freiler.

The Temporary Guardian of the Estate of Donald Freiler shall have all of the powers and duties of a Guardian of the Estate including, but not limited to, the power to employ counsel and to make decisions regarding administrative proceedings now pending before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission involving Reading Metro Cab, Inc., a Pennsylvania business corporation of which Donald Freiler is the sole shareholder, to oversee and manage said business generally, by retaining Curt Stricker as an agent to manage same and otherwise, and to maintain and care for all other property of the said Donald Freiler.

The Temporary Guardian of the Person of Donald Freiler shall have all of the powers of a Guardian of the Person including, but not limited to, the authority to sign any consent forms which may be required in order to obtain proper medical and hospital care and treatment for Donald Freiler.

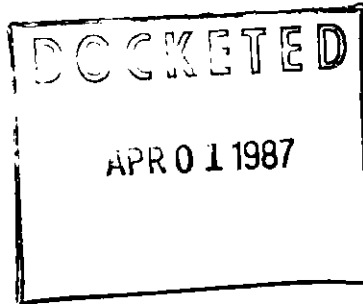

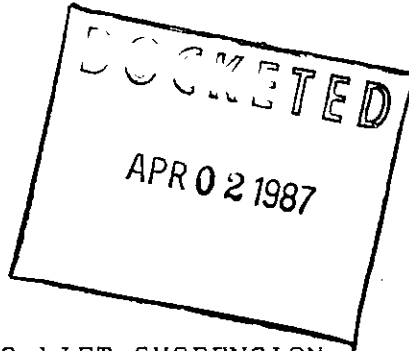

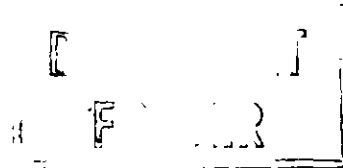

Our office is involved in an uninsured motorist claim on behalf of Allstate Insurance Company which was filed by Peggy Picasso as a result of an accident that occurred on December 26, 1985. Attached please find a police accident investigation report for the above-mentioned accident.
