

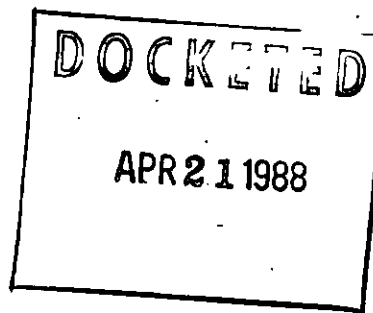

Failure to file the Annual Report within the extension period may result in the imposition of penalties, which could include cancellation of the carrier's certificate or permit as provided by law.

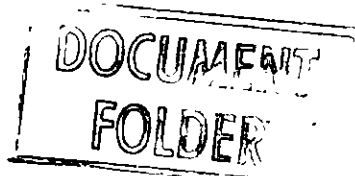


Dear Mr. Rich:

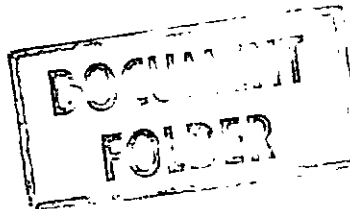

The Petition of FREDERICK O. BRUBAKER, EXECUTOR, by his attorney, WILLIAM R. FORRY, ESQUIRE, respectfully represents that:

1. Donald C. Freiler died on May 7, 1988 leaving a Last Will and Testament dated March 17, 1988, which Last Will and Testament was probated in the Register of Wills Office of Berks County, Pennsylvania in Will Book Volume 234, page 144, wherein he appointed Frederick O. Brubaker as Executor, and Letters Testamentary were issued to Frederick O. Brubaker as Executor by the Register of Wills of Berks County on May 10, 1988.

2. Donald C. Freiler at the time of his death was the operator and owner of all shares of stock of Reading Metro Taxi Cab, Inc., a Pennsylvania corporation engaged in providing call and demand taxicab service in the City of Reading and its

environs under Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission Certificate No. PA 101102.


3. Prior to the death of Donald C. Freiler the Reading Metro Taxi Cab, Inc. had been operated since October 1, 1986 by Curtis G. Stricker under Order of the Orphans' Court Division of the Court of Common Pleas of Berks County appointing him guardian of the Estate of Donald C. Freiler.

4. Under the terms of the Will of Donald C. Freiler, copy attached hereto marked Exhibit "A", Curtis G. Stricker is the sole residuary heir of the Estate of Donald C. Freiler and specifically of all the shares of stock in the Reading Metro Taxi Cab, Inc.

5. As Executor of the aforesaid estate your Petitioner verily believes it will be for the benefit of the estate as well as the residuary heir to continue the operation of Reading Metro Taxi Cab, Inc.

Dear Barry:

You will recall that we discussed the current situation of Reading Metro Taxi Cab Inc. wherein the sole owner of the stock in that corporation died on May 7, 1988. I was seeking a determination as to whether a Petition to the Commission was necessary as the one year anniversary of his death approached. Following that discussion I have had the opportunity to talk to Kirk House in the Law Bureau about this matter.

I was advised by Mr. House that 52 Pa. Code Section 31.4 (b) refers to "the death of an individual holder of a certificate" and it does not apply to a corporation holding such a certificate. Therefore, the corporation will continue to hold the certificate under the Estate of Mr. Freiler until the estate is settled.

As a taxicab driver I have been leasing from Reading Metro Taxi 615 Elm Street Reading, Pennsylvania from 2/10/92 until 12/10/94.

It will be greatly appreciated if you would check into the legalities and or defend my complaint on your behalf.

When I started my position with Reading Metro Taxi, it was agreed upon as stated on paragraph # 14 of our agreement that a driver is responsible for damages incurred when an accident is at fault of the cab driver. This policy has been followed up by charging the cab driver at fault a \$10.00 increase on a daily basis until the estimated damages are paid.


In July of 1993, I was involved in an accident. The other driver failed to adhere to a LEFT LANE MUST TURN LEFT sign at an intersection as I was shifting lanes and he collided into my cab. Unfortunately, instead of the company backing me up on a citation for careless driving, they paid off all the parties for damages and loss of work while leaving me with the obligation to persue the matter on my own and refused to give me any photos at the scene of the accident along with any other information that may have helped my defense. Needless to say I lost my case.

On the other hand, Reading Metro Taxi did not feel that the accident was completely my fault and did not impose the paragraph #14 of our agreement for the remainder of my services with them ending 12/10/94.

However, in early 1994, I'm not sure of the exact date but, Reading Metro Taxi decided to start a new policy requiring all drivers to pay an extra \$5.00 on top of their daily leases and put these monies into an escrow payable 180 days after resigning provided there are no accidents or tickets pending.

Since this new policy took effect, Reading Metro Taxi has been holding over \$300.00 in my name and I never received any notice denying me of this money. On June 10th, 1995, I went in to pick up my money and they refused to give it to me. They told me that they felt Reading Metro Taxi was obligated to keep my money because of paragraph #14 in our contract. According to Fredrick Brubaker Esq. and owner of Reading Metro Taxi, he advised me not to persue this issue because he could still sue me for the damages of the July 1993 accident.

I feel I have a right to this money that Mr. Brubaker refuses to give to me. I was not in an accident since this new policy took effect nor have I received any other traffic violations. I am hoping you will look into this matter and tell me whether or not they have the legal right to withhold this money or even impose such a policy in the first place. Thank you.

The Company's Accountant has prepared a statement for the present year, which will end December 31, 2007, copy enclosed. This clearly indicates a financial hardship.

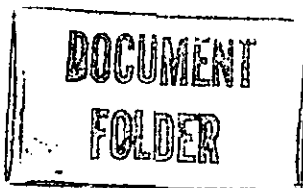

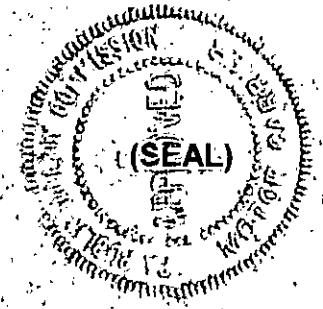
