

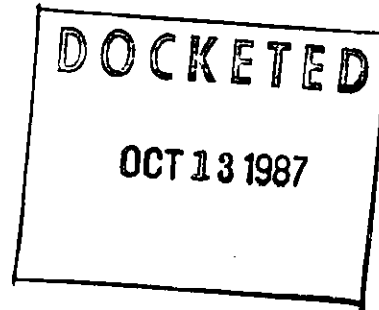



Dear Mr. Bausher:

This is in response to your letter of inquiry received on September 22, 1987 requesting a confirmation of whether or not Reading Metro Taxicab, Inc. was insured on December 26, 1985, and whether or not it held PUC operating authority at that time.

A review of Commission records reveals that Reading Metro's bodily injury and property damage insurance expired on December 9, 1985. The Commission suspended Reading Metro's certificate of public convenience effective that date. Commission records indicate that Reading Metro did not renew its insurance until December 31, 1985; therefore, it was uninsured on the date of the December 26, 1985 accident. The Commission lifted the suspension of the certificate on February 6, 1986 after having received evidence of renewed insurance.
