

1. On or about September 12, 2011, David H. Logan (“Complainant”) filed a Formal Complaint with the Commission against Penelec at the above-referenced docket number.
2. On or about October 12, 2011, Penelec timely filed an Answer with New Matter to the Formal Complaint.
3. An Initial telephonic Hearing was scheduled for Tuesday, August 14, 2012. Counsel for the Complainant requested a continuance of that hearing, which was granted. Thereafter, two additional hearing continuance requests were made and granted.
4. The Company certifies that the parties entered into settlement discussions and have successfully achieved a resolution of the case. The Complainant has indicated that he is satisfied and will not pursue the Complaint further.


