2. The averments stating the time and date of the inspection noted in the Complaint are admitted.

3. Denied in part. The averments regarding violation of the regulations as to air conditioning and low beam headlights were the result of a blown fuse(s). Neither Capital City nor its driver was aware of the problem(s) until the inspection by the Commission agent; said problems were corrected as soon as possible subsequent. Capital City affirms the alleged violation for a dirty trunk.

4. Capital City, because of the mitigating circumstance stated above, prays for lenience regarding the two alleged violations regarding the blown fuse(s).

WHEREFORE, Capital City Cab Service requests a hearing regarding the penalties imposed by the Commission in this matter.
