

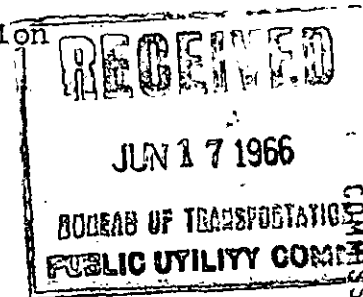


You have issued Suspension Notices to the two above named carriers for failure to file a certificate of cargo insurance.

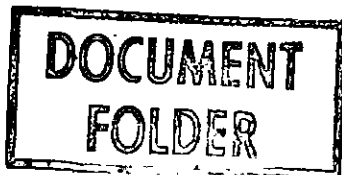

Your prompt attention to this matter will be appreciated.

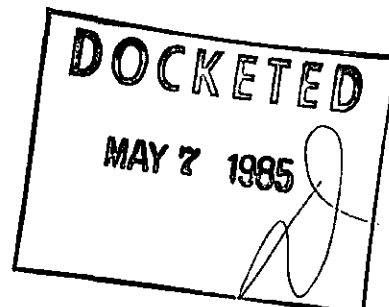
