

ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

Frick Transfer, Inc. (Carrier) furnishes household goods in use services originating in Northampton County as thoroughly described in the order granting authority.

Carrier has filed the 4th Revised Page 41 to Tariff Freight Pa. PUC No. 54, on June 15, 2006.

Carrier proposes to increase its rates by including a minimum transportation charge of four hours at the applicable hourly rate for weekdays and Saturdays, any hour. Carrier previously had a four hour minimum transportation charge for weekdays and Saturdays from 5:01 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. The current hourly rates, which have been in effect since July 30, 2001, have not been changed.

Carrier has submitted a tariff and documentation, in compliance with 52 Pa. Code §23.67(c), for carriers of household goods in use, with gross annual intrastate revenues of less than \$200,000 and an operating ratio of not less than 93%.

ANALYSIS

Carrier proposes increase its rates by including a minimum transportation charge of four hours at the applicable hourly rate for weekdays and Saturdays, any hour. The current hourly rates, which have been in effect since July 30, 2001, have not been changed.


CONCLUSION

We have determined that the increase is not an excessive amount based on the operating ratio. We believe that the increase will be sufficient to provide safe, dependable and continuous service to the public. The Carrier has no outstanding fines or assessment due; THEREFORE,
