Dear Mr. Widdemer:

It was a pleasure speaking to you today regarding your formal complaint. Per our telephone conversation today, this letter confirms the resolution of the above-referenced Public Utility Commission (PUC) Complaint. As the parties desire to amicably resolve the dispute without the need for further litigation, PECO Energy has agreed to resolve your formal complaint as follows:

- (1) PECO Energy Senior Rates Engineer, Scott Neumann, confirmed that the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission approved the \$1.75 meter fee during the company's last rate case at Docket No. R-2010-2161575;
- (2) The \$1.75 meter charge for the Off Peak meter was approved and implemented in PECO Energy's tariff. See attached Tariff.
- (3) Mr. Neumann advised you that PECO Energy has no plans to file a rate case in the foreseeable future. In the event the company does file a rate case, there would be a minimum of three (3) years to prepare the case to go forward. Accordingly, you should not anticipate any increase in the \$1.75 charge in the near future.

This letter memorializes the entire resolution between William Widdemer and PECO Energy Company. Any other terms or promises, written or oral, not in the body of this letter will not be a part of this settlement agreement and, therefore, will be void.
